Many are toxic

High fat content

HOLLY BERRIES and leaves can cause vomiting, belly pain, depression and diarrhea.

MISTLETOE is extremely toxic and an animal that has ingested some should be taken to the veterinarian immediately.

PINE TREE NEEDLES can be toxic and cause irritation of the mouth.

LILY is deadly to cats. Any animal that has ingested any part of a lily should be taken to the veterinarian immediately.

Deadly Snacks to Avoid

CHOCOLATE

sometimes contains ingredients that can be lethal to dogs and cats

MACADAMIA NUTS

are very toxic and can cause seizures in animals

Causes an upset stomach, gastrointestinal distress, and pancreatitis

Found to cause obstructions in the throat and intestinal tract
