



Darvall's ZDS Qube system* with unidirectional gas flow and sealed face masks delivers low flow, rapid response predictable anaesthesia to exotics from a stable aluminum block. The New Heated ZDS Qube warms inspired gas to 41.5°C to reduce heat loss during anaesthesia

The patented Darvall ZDS face mask system, developed from over 10 years of research, overcomes all of the problems of the older very small patient anaesthesia mask systems. ZDS masks use innovative uni-directional gas flow which eliminates the mask dead space, so prevents rebreathing of CO₂ and provides very predictable delivery of anaesthetic gas to the animal's nose (see diagram). Fresh gas flows as low as 200 ml/kg/min. deliver stable anaesthesia with rapid response to changes in vapouriser settings (typically in 2 to 3 breaths). The ZDS Qube has interchangeable masks with soft diaphragms designed to seal on the nose of birds, reptiles, rabbits, rodents and exotics of all sizes which eliminates occupational waste gas pollution to the working environment. Because the mask system is sealed, the fresh anaesthetic and oxygen gas flow (200 ml/kg/min) flushes the expired breath containing CO₂ out into the waste gas system.

Darvall's heated ZDS Qube provides a totally new solution to hypothermia in these very small patients by delivering warm inspired gas to the animal's nose. This system incorporates animal and Qube temperature monitoring, providing closed loop feedback. There is computerised data acquisition capability via USB for display and record keeping.





Darvall's small diameter, smooth wall tubing has been shown to produce less resistance than typical 22mm corrugated tubing. Darvall SWT 16mm ID x 1.6M long can support animals up to 80kg with less than 0.5cm H₂O pressure drop; Darvall SWT 12mm ID x 1.6M long can support animals up to 40kg [see graph]^{1,2}.






Hypothermia during anaesthesia

Multiple causes

- Small body size
- Vasodilation from premedication and anaesthetic drugs
- Heat loss from skin surface or open body cavities
- Lack of shiver response
- Inhalation of cold, dry anaesthetic gases

Stages of development of hypothermia during anaesthesia



Challenges in Practice

Hypothermia slows recovery from anaesthesia:


- Doubles recovery time
- Occupies nurse time in monitoring and re-warming cold patients
- Delays discharge, especially for out-patients

Challenges for Patients

Hypothermia increases risk of related problems:

- Slow heart rate and respiratory depression
- Slow metabolism of drugs, slows recovery
- Pain at surgical site due to shivering in recovery
- Pain as vasoconstriction reduces distribution of analgesic drugs
- Airway obstruction in semi-conscious patients
- Risk of burns with many warming devices
